79. **HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT PLAN**

Suggestions put forward for inclusion in the HIP were the items already proposed last year when KCC Cllr Kennedy undertook a survey of highway issues in Ditton and those highway issues considered on the Planning Obligations plus one other item:

- Road markings to slow the traffic in St Peter's Road particularly on the bend
- Footpaths upto Woodlands parade need maintenance as they are broken and uneven
- Provision of pedestrian footway from Franklin Kidd Lane to Ragstone Court
- New footpath in Cherry Orchard
- 20mph speed limit in village, particularly main routes and traffic calming in Kilnbarn Road to slow traffic as it comes into the village
- Road restructure to Brampton Field
- Fernleigh Rise Parking Issues
- Keep clear box for traffic turning right into Bell Lane from the A20
